Growing The Spirit Man – Part 3

1 Samuel 17:33, 42 KJV: ³³And Saul said to David, Thou art not able to go against this Philistine to fight with him: for thou art but a youth, and he a man of war from his youth. ⁴²And when the Philistine looked about, and saw David, he disdained him: for he was but a youth, and ruddy, and of a fair countenance.

Numbers 13:33 KJV: And there we saw the giants, the sons of Anak, which come of the giants: and we were in our own sight as grasshoppers, and so we were in their sight.

Growing your spirit man enables you to see beyond natural limitations. David was too young for Saul and too insignificant for Goliath. The spies also saw themselves as grasshoppers before the giants. God does not choose people based on human qualifications but by His anointing.

2 Corinthians 4:16 KJV: For which cause we faint not; but though our outward man perish, yet the inward man is renewed day by day.

Whether young or old, what matters is the condition of the spirit (inward) man. Unlike the body, the spirit man can grow stronger every day.

Zechariah 4:6 KJV: Then he answered and spake unto me, saying, This is the word of the LORD unto Zerubbabel, saying, Not by might, nor by power, but by my spirit, saith the LORD of hosts.

Beloved, invest in your spirit man. God's strength is revealed through those who depend on Him.
