The Man Jesse

Every child carries a purpose ordained by God. May every father seek the face of the Lord so that His purpose for each child may be understood and nurtured.

The Scriptures do not tell us much about Jesse's relationship with David, but they do reveal something remarkable. When Samuel came to anoint the next king of Israel, Jesse presented seven of his sons before the prophet. David was left tending the sheep.

1 Samuel 16:10–11 (KJV) *“Again, Jesse made seven of his sons to pass before Samuel. And Samuel said unto Jesse, The LORD hath not chosen these. And Samuel said unto Jesse, Are here all thy children? And he said, There remaineth yet the youngest, and, behold, he keepeth the sheep...”*

David would later write:

Psalms 69:8 (KJV) *“I am become a stranger unto my brethren, and an alien unto my mother's children.”*

Whatever Jesse's expectations may have been, he did not appear to recognise the extraordinary purpose God had for David's life.

As fathers, we must do better. Decisions concerning our children should never be reduced to guesswork. They carry eternal significance and must be approached prayerfully.

Jacob provides a powerful example. He sought God's mind concerning his children and grandchildren.

Genesis 48:14, 19 (KJV) *“And Israel stretched out his right hand, and laid it upon Ephraim's head... guiding his hands wittingly... And his father refused, and said, I know it, my son, I know it...”*

Genesis 49:1 (KJV) *“And Jacob called unto his sons, and said, Gather yourselves together, that I may tell you that which shall befall you in the last days.”*

May God reveal to us His plans for our children, and may we have the wisdom and courage to walk in them.
