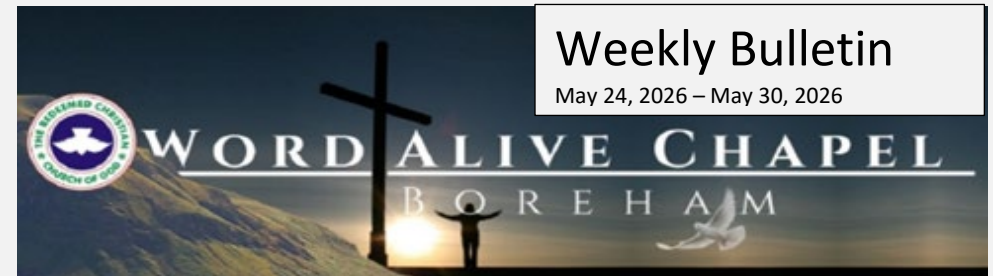

Growing the Spirit Man – Part 2

You cannot see God or relate with the spirit world through natural sensory organs. God is Spirit, and we relate with Him through spiritual senses. Interestingly, the spirit man also possesses sensory organs.

2 Kings 6:15–17 (KJV): *“And when the servant of the man of God was risen early, and gone forth, behold, an host compassed the city both with horses and chariots... And Elisha prayed, and said, LORD, I pray thee, open his eyes, that he may see... and, behold, the mountain was full of horses and chariots of fire round about Elisha.”*

Gehazi saw only the Syrian army with physical eyes. He could not see the angels surrounding them for protection. Elisha, however, could see beyond the natural realm because his spiritual eyes were active.

Hebrews 5:12–14 (KJV): *“But strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, even those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.”*

The Bible also speaks of “chewing” the Word of God. How do you chew the Word of God? Certainly, not with the regular human mouth. This points to spiritual senses being developed through maturity.

Psalms 18:34 (KJV): *“He teacheth my hands to war, so that a bow of steel is broken by mine arms.”*

There are also spiritual hands. God can train and anoint your hands to accomplish extraordinary things.

Beloved, your spirit man must grow. Just as you would need food, water, minerals to grow your human sensory organs, you must seek to develop your Spiritual senses as well through prayer and continual feeding on the Word of God and fasting.

Maranatha — Come, Lord Jesus.
