Growing The Spirit Man – Part 4

1 Kings 19:7-8 KJV *And the angel of the LORD came again the second time, and touched him, and said, Arise and eat; because the journey is too great for thee. ⁸ And he arose, and did eat and drink, and went in the strength of that meat forty days and forty nights unto Horeb the mount of God.*

This account reveals an important truth about the developed spirit man.

Those who walk closely with God experience His supernatural provision. God supplies the strength required for every assignment He gives. Elijah travelled forty days and forty nights on the strength of one meal prepared by God.

Earlier, the same Elijah outran Ahab's chariot.

1 Kings 18:45-46 KJV *And it came to pass in the mean while, that the heaven was black with clouds and wind, and there was a great rain. And Ahab rode, and went to Jezreel. ⁴⁶ And the hand of the LORD was on Elijah; and he girded up his loins, and ran before Ahab to the entrance of Jezreel*

The believer whose spirit is growing can experience the powers of the world to come, not by natural ability but by the enabling of God.

Nehemiah 9:20-21 KJV “Thou gavest also thy good spirit to instruct them... Yea, forty years didst thou sustain them in the wilderness, so that they lacked nothing; their clothes waxed not old, and their feet swelled not.”
