Vision of The Lost

William Booth once described a vision that shook his heart. He saw a dark and stormy ocean. Lightning flashed, thunder roared, and waves crashed violently. In that sea were countless people — struggling, screaming, sinking. Some rose briefly only to disappear beneath the waters forever.

Then he saw a great Rock rising high above the storm. Around its base was a platform where rescued people stood safely. They had once been in the sea, but now they were secure. Some on the Rock were helping to pull others out. A few even jumped back into the sea to rescue the drowning.

But most did something shocking.

They began planting flowers. They traded goods. They argued about religion. They sang songs. They prayed for comfort. They made plans for the future. They even asked the Lord to come and make them happier on the Rock.

Meanwhile, Christ Himself was in the sea — calling out, struggling to save the perishing, crying, “Come to Me! Come and help Me!”
The rescued heard Him — but did not move.

Booth said the sea was life without Christ.
The Rock was Calvary.
The drowning were the lost.
And those on the Rock were the saved.

Our church stands for evangelism. England is that sea. Christ is still calling. The question is not whether we are saved.
The question is this: **Will we jump into the sea?**
Maranatha — Come, Lord Jesus.
