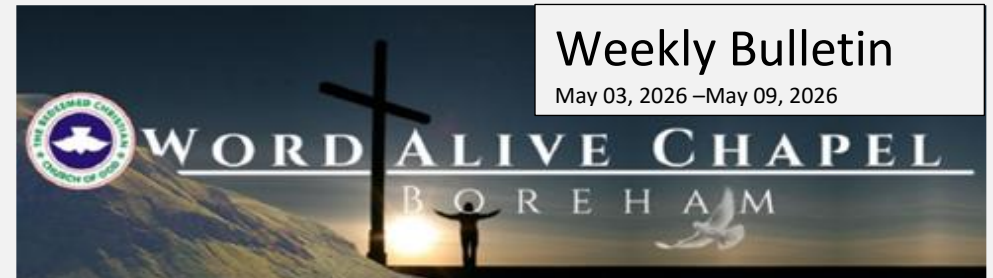

Let Thanksgiving Replace Fear.

Colossians 1:12-14 KJV: Giving thanks unto the Father, which hath made us meet to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in light: ¹³Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated us into the kingdom of his dear Son: ¹⁴In whom we have redemption through his blood, even the forgiveness of sins.

If you truly walk in the realities of redemption, your heart will be filled with thanksgiving and fear will lose its hold on you.

Through Christ, you have been brought into the family of God. This redemption is not symbolic; it is a real repositioning. You have been translated from the kingdom of darkness into the kingdom of God. In this new position, the devil no longer has authority over you.

This truth must become your **confession and thanksgiving**. Begin to thank God for bringing you to Himself; into a place where His rule prevails and the enemy has no dominion over your life. As you do, you will find that thanksgiving drives out fear.

Your new position determines your experience. What is available in your new kingdom should shape your expectations. If sickness and oppression are not native to your new location, then they should not be your portion.

Beloved, begin to think and live from your new identity in Christ. Let your heart be filled with praise, and let fear give way to faith.
