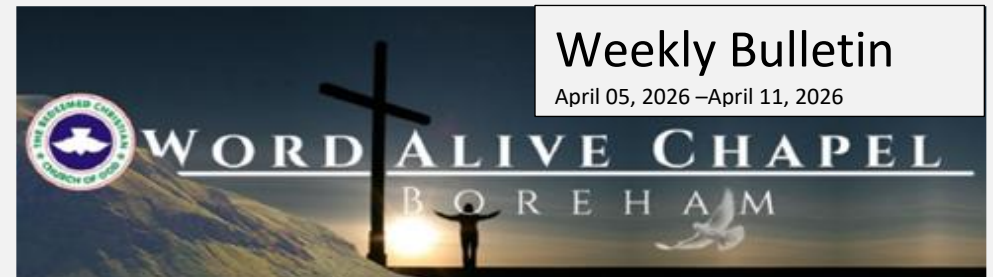

Delegated Authority in Christ.

Death and resurrection of Jesus Christ earned for every believer, delegated authority.

Authority in Greek means Exousia (ἐξουσία) and it can be translated to mean:

- Delegated power
- The right to act
- Jurisdiction

Authority is the right to command while power (Dumanis) is the ability to carry out. A King has authority while Soldiers carry out.

This resurrection Sunday, consider how Jesus this received authority:

a. By Identity (Son of God)

John 5:26–27 KJV: ⁶ For as the Father hath life in himself; so hath he given to the Son to have life in himself; ²⁷ And hath given him authority to execute judgment also, because he is the Son of man.

b. By Obedience

Philippians 2:8-9 KJV: And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross. ⁹ Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name

c. By Victory over Satan

Matthew 28:18 KJV: And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth.

Because Christ has authority, and we are in Him, we now walk in delegated authority as believers. Walk in it. Live in it. Exercise it. Maranatha — Come, Lord Jesus.

Prayer Points

- Ask God for forgiveness of your sins. Lord, search my heart, cleanse me from every hidden sin, and give me grace to live holy before You.
