Growing The Inner Man Part 5.

I have never known a man of peace like God. He so much respects your wishes. There is no force with Him. To grow the inner man demands that we interact with God through the Holy Spirit. This requires submission and obedience.

2 Peter 3:18 KJV: *But grow in grace, and in the knowledge of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. To him be glory both now and for ever. Amen.*

Genesis 6:3 KJV: *And GOD saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually.*

Genesis 6:5 KJV: *And GOD saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually."*

Humanity had become exceedingly wicked (Genesis 6:5). God had been striving with mankind convicting, warning, and calling them to repentance but they continually resisted Him. So God declared that His Spirit would not strive with them indefinitely. He gave them 120 years before judgment came through the flood.

God is patient, but His patience should never be presumed upon particularly if you desire that your spirit man should grow.

To grow the inner man, you should be willing to listen and follow God's instructions. If the Holy Spirit instructs once, you should be willing to hear twice. Obedience to the Holy Spirit is the hallmark of those who are growing in the inner man.
