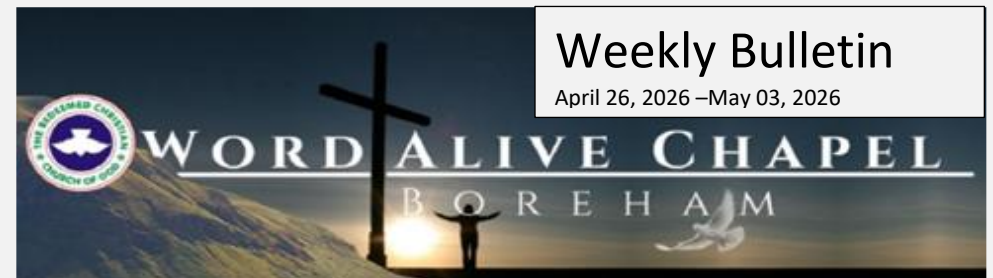

Cloud Of Witnesses

Difficult times can be stressful. No one desires them, yet the Bible makes it clear that such seasons will come especially for believers..
Acts 14:22 KJV - Confirming the souls of the disciples, and exhorting them to continue in the faith, and that we must through much tribulation enter into the kingdom of God.

Every believer should understand the following:

1. **You are not alone:** Whatever you are going through or may yet face, others have gone through similar trials and remained faithful to God.
2. **God is faithful:** He will see you through.

1 Corinthians 10:13 KJV - There hath no temptation taken you but such as is common to man: but God is faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that ye may be able to bear it.

3. In all situations, God's will for you is to stand and not faint
4. **Those who endured are witnesses of God's faithfulness:**
Their lives testify that it is possible to remain steadfast.
5. **Their examples remove our excuses:**

Hebrews 11:7 KJV - By faith Noah, being warned of God of things not seen as yet, moved with fear, prepared an ark to the saving of his house; by the which he condemned the world, and became heir of the righteousness which is by faith.

Matthew 12:41 KJV - The men of Nineveh shall rise in judgment with this generation, and shall condemn it: because they repented at the preaching of Jonas; and, behold, a greater than Jonas is here.

The cloud of witnesses stands as a reminder: God has done it before, and He will do it again. *Maranatha — Come, Lord Jesus.*

Prayer Points

- Praise God today. He is good and His mercies endure forever.
- Ask God for forgiveness of your sins. Lord, search my heart, cleanse me from every hidden sin, and give me grace to live holy before You.
- Like in the days of Pentecost, shall we ask for the power of the Holy Spirit to fill us that we may serve God effectively.
