God and God Alone

Psalm 40:1–4, 2 Samuel 23:8–39;

The great deliverance described in Scripture points to God alone as the source of help. David's life shows God's intervention in difficult times and reminds us to always acknowledge Him. God does not share His glory with anyone — not even with those He has helped.

Isaiah 42:8 (KJV) *"I am the LORD: that is my name: and my glory will I not give to another..."*

Deuteronomy 8:17 (KJV) *"And thou say in thine heart, My power and the might of mine hand hath gotten me this wealth."*

David consistently acknowledged and returned all glory to God:

Psalm 40:1,4 (KJV): *"I waited patiently for the LORD; and he inclined unto me, and heard my cry. ⁴Blessed is that man that maketh the Lord his trust, and respecteth not the proud, nor such as turn aside to lies."*

While we give glory to God, we must also appreciate those He uses to help us. However, we must never become so attached to people so much that we start compromise the Word of God.

David had strong human support, yet he never misplaced his source.

Psalm 121:1 (KJV): *I will lift up mine eyes unto the hills, from whence cometh my help."*

He understood the "horrible pit." In the cave of Adullam, danger was real, yet God delivered him.

True deliverance produces one response: testimony and thanksgiving.
