Beyond Your Limits

Psalms 8:1-4 KJV *O LORD our Lord, how excellent is thy name in all the earth! who hast set thy glory above the heavens. ² Out of the mouth of babes and sucklings hast thou ordained strength because of thine enemies, that thou mightest still the enemy and the avenger. ³ When I consider thy heavens, the work of thy fingers, the moon and the stars, which thou hast ordained; ⁴ What is man, that thou art mindful of him? and the son of man, that thou visitest him?*

Ezekiel 22:30 KJV: And I sought for a man among them, that should make up the hedge, and stand in the gap before me for the land, that I should not destroy it: but I found none.

Isaiah 6:8 KJV: Also I heard the voice of the Lord, saying, Whom shall I send, and who will go for us? Then said I, Here am I; send me.

One recurring themes of Scripture is that God is always looking for people through whom He can accomplish His purposes and display His power. He sought Noah in a corrupt generation. He called Abraham to leave everything familiar. He met Moses at the burning bush. He found Gideon hiding in fear. He chose David, a shepherd boy. The issue is never whether God is able. He is always able.

The question is whether there are men and women who are willing to trust Him and make themselves available to Him. When God finds such people, He takes them beyond their natural limits. They accomplish what they could never have achieved in their own strength—not by might, nor by power, but by His Spirit.

You can dare to trust Him. **Maranatha — Come, Lord Jesus.**
