Growing The Spirit Man.

We need functioning sensory organs (eyes for sight, ears for hearing, the tongue and nose for taste and smell, and the skin for touch) to operate successfully in the physical world. Anyone unable to speak, hear, see, feel, or taste will face difficulties in daily life.

In the same way, anyone who refuses to develop the spirit man will struggle to relate properly with God. Beloved, you are first a spirit being. You have a soul, and you live in a physical body.

1 Thessalonians 5:23 (KJV): “And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly; and I pray God your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.”

God, your Creator, desires fellowship with you. No man connects with God through the five physical senses. We relate with Him through the spirit man, which must therefore be developed and strengthened.

John 4:24 (KJV): God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth.

How then do you grow the spirit man? By feeding on the Word of God. The Word is the spiritual nourishment required for growth.

1 Peter 2:2 (KJV): As newborn babes, desire the sincere milk of the word, that ye may grow thereby:

Jeremiah 15:16 (KJV): Thy words were found, and I did eat them; and thy word was unto me the joy and rejoicing of mine heart...”

Psalms 119:103 (KJV): How sweet are thy words unto my taste! yea, sweeter than honey to my mouth!

Just as the physical body requires food and water to grow, the spirit man requires the Word of God.

From next week, we shall begin to examine why you should care deeply about your spirit man.
