Growing The Inner Man Part 9

Hebrews 5:13-14 KJV ¹³For every one that useth milk is unskilful in the word of righteousness: for he is a babe. ¹⁴But strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, even those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.

There can be no sustained growth of the inner man unless a believer learns to remain faithful through the trials, temptations and challenges of life. Consider these experiences as opportunities for spiritual exercise. As you faithfully walk through them with God, your faith, discernment and confidence in Him grow stronger.

Acts 12:11 KJV And when Peter was come to himself, he said, Now I know of a surety, that the Lord hath sent his angel, and hath delivered me out of the hand of Herod, and *from* all the expectation of the people of the Jews.

Every victory through a trial or temptation can take you another step towards becoming whom God has ordained you to be. Consider Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego. Their unwavering confidence in God's ability to deliver them did not suddenly begin at the fiery furnace. Earlier, they had already demonstrated faithfulness by refusing to defile themselves with the king's provision.

Daniel 3:17-18 KJV If it be so, our God whom we serve is able to deliver us from the burning fiery furnace, and he will deliver *us* out of thine hand, O king. But if not, be it known unto thee, O king, that we will not serve thy gods, nor worship the golden image which thou hast set up.

Beloved, today's faithfulness prepares you for tomorrow's greater tests. If you desire to grow in God's wisdom and in your knowledge of Him, remain faithful in every season. **Maranatha — Come, Lord Jesus.**
