Acceptable Offerings Part 1.

Genesis 4:3–5 (KJV): And in process of time it came to pass, that Cain brought of the fruit of the ground an offering unto the LORD. And Abel, he also brought of the firstlings of his flock and of the fat thereof. And the LORD had respect unto Abel and to his offering: But unto Cain and to his offering he had not respect.

Scripture does not record God commanding Cain and Abel to bring these offerings. Nevertheless, both came before God with an offering. Yet one was accepted and the other was rejected.

Notice something important: God had respect “**unto Abel and to his offering,**” but “**unto Cain and to his offering he had not respect.**”

God was not looking merely at what was placed before Him; He was also looking at the person who brought it.

This principle runs throughout Scripture. God desires more than what is in your hand. **He wants you first.**

2 Corinthians 8:5 (KJV): “*And this they did, not as we hoped, but first gave their own selves to the Lord, and unto us by the will of God.*”

Before the Macedonians gave their possessions, they first gave themselves to the Lord.

An acceptable offering therefore begins with an offered life. God is interested in your money, time, talents and service, but He wants the giver before the gift.

Beloved, before placing something upon God's altar, ask yourself: Have I first placed myself there? **Maranatha — Come, Lord Jesus.**

Prayer Points

- Give thanks to God for everything in your life. As you praise Him, He will beautify you.
- Ask God for forgiveness of your sins. Lord, search my heart, cleanse me from every hidden sin, and give me grace to live holy before You.
