Acceptable Offerings Part 2

Genesis 4:4–5 (KJV): *“And Abel, he also brought of the firstlings of his flock and of the fat thereof. And the LORD had respect unto Abel and to his offering: But unto Cain and to his offering he had not respect.”*

Why did God have respect unto Abel and his offering?

1. Abel was righteous before God.

Matthew 23:35 (KJV): *“...from the blood of righteous Abel unto the blood of Zacharias son of Barachias...”*

Jesus Himself described Abel as **righteous**. The condition of the giver matters to God.

2. Abel brought God the first and choice portions of his flock.

Genesis 4:4 (KJV): *“And Abel, he also brought of the firstlings of his flock and of the fat thereof.”*

“Firstlings” refers to the firstborn of the flock, as confirmed in **Exodus 13:12, Deuteronomy 15:19 and Numbers 18:17**. “The fat thereof” refers to the fat portions, as belonging particularly to the Lord (**Leviticus 3:16**). Abel's offering reflected honour towards God.

3. Abel offered his sacrifice in faith.

Hebrews 11:4 (KJV): *“By faith Abel offered unto God a more excellent sacrifice than Cain, by which he obtained witness that he was righteous, God testifying of his gifts...”*

Beloved, an acceptable offering is not merely about what you give. The giver, the quality of the gift, and the faith with which it is offered all matter before God. May the Lord have respect unto you and your offering.

Maranatha — Come, Lord Jesus.

- Give thanks to God for everything in your life. As you praise Him, He will beautify you.
- Ask God for forgiveness of your sins. Lord, search my heart, cleanse me from every hidden sin, and give me grace to live holy before You.
