Acceptable Offerings – Part 3: The Macedonians' Example

2 Corinthians 8:1-5 (KJV): *"Moreover, brethren, we do you to wit of the grace of God bestowed on the churches of Macedonia; ²How that in a great trial of affliction the abundance of their joy and their deep poverty abounded unto the riches of their liberality. ³For to their power, I bear record, yea, and beyond their power they were willing of themselves; ⁴Praying us with much intreaty that we would receive the gift, and take upon us the fellowship of the ministering to the saints. And this they did, not as we hoped, but first gave their own selves to the Lord, and unto us by the will of God"*

Apostle Paul cited the churches of Macedonian as an example of giving worthy of commendation. What did they do?

1. The hardship they experienced did not stop them from giving.
They were experiencing *"a great trial of affliction"* and *"deep poverty,"* yet these circumstances did not close their hearts. Instead, they gave generously to meet the needs of other believers.

2. They gave sacrificially.
Paul testified that they gave *"to their power"* and even *"beyond their power."* Their giving went beyond convenience; it involved sacrifice.

3. They gave themselves to God before giving their resources
This was the foundation of their generosity: *"first gave their own selves to the Lord."* They surrendered themselves to God and willingly submitted to His will, working together with His servants in accomplishing His purpose.

Beloved, acceptable giving begins with a surrendered life. May our offerings flow from hearts that belong completely to God.

Maranatha — Come, Lord Jesus.

Prayer Points

Give thanks to God for everything in your life. As you praise Him, pray that He will beautify your life with His salvation, favour and goodness.

Ask God for the forgiveness of your sins. Pray: "Lord, search my heart, cleanse me from every hidden sin, and give me grace to live a holy life before You."

Pray for the Praise Concert coming up on 19 September 2026. Ask that God's presence will be mighty among us and that, through the praises offered to Him, souls will be saved, the sick healed, and those in bondage delivered.
