Acceptable Offerings – Part 4: A Living Sacrifice

Romans 12:1 (KJV): *“I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service.”*

The more we understand what it means to be a **living sacrifice**, the easier it becomes for our offerings to be acceptable unto God.

A living sacrifice is a person who has placed his entire life on God's altar. He remains physically alive but no longer regards himself as belonging to himself. His life belongs to God.

It is from this position of surrender that we are able to give and serve without holding back.

Luke 21:3–4 (KJV): *“Of a truth I say unto you, that this poor widow hath cast in more than they all... she of her penury hath cast in all the living that she had.”*

A living sacrifice puts God's will above personal interest. True sacrifice has a cost. David understood this:

2 Samuel 24:24 (KJV): *“Neither will I offer burnt offerings unto the LORD my God of that which doth cost me nothing.”*

Beloved, God does not only desire something **from you**; He desires **you**. When the life has first been placed upon the altar, our giving and service flow from genuine surrender.

May your life be an acceptable offering unto God, and may your sacrifices be pleasing unto Him.
